### A RESOLUTION OPPOSING CONSTRUCTION OF A 500KV ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION LINE IN BUCKINGHAM COUNTY, VIRGINIA

WHEREAS, Virginia Power proposes to build a 500 Kv transmission lines across an approximate 33 miles of Buckingham County; and

WHEREAS, the Buckingham County Board of Supervisors has deep concerns regarding the negative impact that such a line would have upon the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Buckingham County; and

WHEREAS, said high voltage transmission lines will have a negative effect upon land value, usage and future development of properties wherein they cross, and the adjacent properties near such lines; and

WHEREAS, it remains inconclusive as to whether such a line would pose significant health hazards to persons and livestock; and

WHEREAS, Buckingham County is a rural County known for its scenic areas, said lines will have an irreparable effect upon the visual and natural beauty of the County and, consequently, an irreparable negative impact upon recreation and tourism in the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Buckingham County, Virginia, in order to assure the health, safety and welfare of it's citizens, does oppose the construction and use of high voltage electrical transmission lines in Buckingham County.
